

## Pathway - Becoming a Multi-sport NCCP Learning Facilitator in Ontario



### **Step 1: Application Process**

The Coaches Association of Ontario (CAO) accepts written applications for Learning Facilitators (LF) interested in facilitating the multi-sport modules of NCCP on an ongoing basis. To become certified to lead sport-specific modules within NCCP, individuals should contact the provincial sport organization directly.

Applications will be considered by the CAO during a pre-scheduled selection period with assistance from the Coach Education Committee and Ontario MCD Team. LF Applications must include:

### **Step 2: Selection of Candidate Learning Facilitators**

LF Candidate pre-requisite training requirements are:

2. Complete and pass [Making Headway Online Module](#)
3. Complete and pass [MED online evaluation](#)
4. Complete [Core Training for Learning Facilitators](#)

LF Candidate Multi Sport training requirements once selected:

5. Complete Content Specific Training (will be arranged by CAO)
6. Complete [Co-delivery prior to delivering](#)
7. Complete NCCP Locker database training

LF ongoing requirements:

8. Sign the CAO Service Level Agreement (SLA)
9. Sign the [Coach Developer Code of Conduct](#)
10. Maintain CAO [membership](#) (this provides insurance coverages for you while you facilitate Multi-Sport workshops)
11. Facilitate a minimum of one workshop every two years
12. Attend PD to maintain certified status
13. Maintain a current email and phone contact registered with CAO database

The number of selected LF candidates will be based on:

- Regional requirements, geographic coverage needs
- Language needs
- New NCCP context trends and requirements
- Course activity demands based on previous year productivity results
- Community needs
- Stakeholder (Host partners, PSOs, and coaches) feedback

The CAO may limit the number of LFs selected.

Recognition will be given to coaching experience, context appropriate coaching, educational background, facilitation background, prior involvement with the NCCP, LTAD and sport development.
