<p>Competition Development For any inquiries please contact Josée Matte: josee@owsa.ca</p>	<p>Coaches will focus on annual performance planning, seasonal phase planning, the use of mental training, travel and tournament planning, sport program design, and planning for peak performance. Coaches will also work on analyzing performance of skills and tactics, including biomechanical analysis, video analysis, and scouting.</p>
